Word	Definition	Graphic/ Symbol
Society	Human beings living together as a group, often joined by a common geography, beliefs, or culture.	
Culture	The civilization of a people at a particular time; its customs, practices, arts, and beliefs.	
Economy	The system of how people produce, trade, and distribute goods and services.	
Religion	A particular system of belief and worship in God, gods, spirits, or ancestors.	
Justice	Fair treatment with deserved reward or punishment. Also the exercise of power and authority to maintain what is just (fair) and right.	
Human Rights	The rights of all human beings to fair treatment, justice, and to basic needs such as food, shelter, and education.	
Hierarchy	An organization of persons and things arranged into higher and lower ranks and classes.	
Government	A system with a person or persons ruling a country state or district.	
Empire	Many states or provinces under the rule of one government. This government often has one person, an emperor or empress, as the head of the government.	
Republic	A nation in which citizens elect representatives to manage the government.
