Question: What values were important to Rome?

Part One: Outline

I. Topic Sentence: This should sum up the main point of the paragraph and respond to the question.

II. Evidence 1: A piece of evidence that supports your topic sentence.

III. Commentary 1: Explain how that evidence supports your claim. What does that piece of evidence tell you about Rome?

IV. Evidence 2: A second piece of evidence that supports your topic sentence.

V. Commentary 2: Explain how this new piece of evidence supports your claim. What does that piece of evidence tell you about Rome?

VI. Concluding Sentence: Restate what the values of Rome are.
