

Wal-Mart wants to Move to Gilbert!

This is a bad idea, and will have a very negative impact on the physical and cultural landscape of our community should Wal-Mart succeed with their plan.



- Wal-Mart wants to build a **200,000 Square Foot Supercenter** next-door the Gilbert Municipal Center at the corner of Gilbert and Warner Roads
- This new Wal-Mart will consume approximately 60% of the limited Gilbert Municipal District Retail Space
- The Gilbert Civic Center Core was originally established to promote a mixed use of government facilities and small scale retail
- Traffic studies indicate that more than 8000 additional cars per day will be added to an area that is already near its capacity
- Increased traffic and congestion will pose addition risks and hazards to the **Elementary Schools** that are **within 1/2 mile** of the proposed site

Gilbert must respond to this super-store expansion by a large corporation that does not value our interests as a community. Building a giant super-store at the *gateway to our community*, in the core of our most cherished and important landscape would be a terrible mistake and must not happen.

Please help stop Wal-Mart from building in our town's civic core!
