



Job Description: The Senior guide is the chosen to represent the rangers as the top junior leader in the outpost.

Senior Patrol Guide Duties:

- Runs all outpost meetings, events, and activities.
- Runs the Gold Bar Council meeting.
- Assigns duties and responsibility to other junior leaders.
- Assists the outpost commander with junior leader training
- Sets a good example
- Wears the ranger uniform correctly
- Lives by the ranger pledge and motto.
- Shows ranger spirit.

Responsibilities:

- As chairman of the Gold Bar Council:
 - Attend all GBC meetings
 - Develop the agenda with the outpost commander before each meeting
 - On outpost outings:
 - Arrive 20 minutes prior to departure.
 - Have a copy of the outdoor program plan
 - Upon arrival have the outpost form up into patrols
 - Dismiss rangers when their responsibilities have been completed.

Outpost meetings:

- Arrive at 645pm and plan to stay till 830pm
- Have the outpost meeting plan
- Have a small GBC meeting following each meeting (5 min maximum)
