Each boy that enters the Royal Rangers Program will be assigned to a Patrol. The patrol is a special group of boys that do things together within each Outpost. The boys of each patrol will select a name in keeping with

the ideals of Royal Rangers and elect it's own Guide. Each week, during the Outpost meetings, time is set aside for patrols to meet. Games will be played between patrols during game periods, and each patrol will be together during ceremonies.
