### Summer Program

The Pack summer program encourages year-round group involvement and a chance for the scouts to earn the coveted *Summer Time Award*. Participating in 3 or more of the summer activities (at least 1 per month) earns an official Cub Scout pin that is worn above the left pocket. Here's the menu of events:

### Downtown Extravaganza

*Contact: Bellmore Family*

**Sunday, June 9<sup>th</sup>, 1:00 - 4:00 p.m.**

**Meet** at the Brookpark Rd. RTA Rapid Station at 1:00. **Ride the train** to Terminal Tower. **Take the elevator** to the observation deck. **Check out the view** of the "Jake" (Indians vs Mets!), the "Home of the Browns", the new library addition and other sights. **Take a ride** on the new "Lakefront Line" train past the new Stadium, Great Lakes Science Center, and Rock-n-Roll Hall of Fame. **Walk** across East 9<sup>th</sup> St. to tour the **Submarine USS COD** ([usscod.org](http://usscod.org)), check out the deck gun and view the cityscape and lakefront through the periscope. **Re-board** the LakeFront Line and ride back into the "flats" to **see** some one-of-a-kind bridges, working freighters and tugs on the river, and all the nice tourist-y things offered in Cleveland.

Not to worry if you're early or late - we find each other (1<sup>st</sup>) at the terminal tower observation deck or (2<sup>nd</sup>) at the dancing fountains at the Tower City "Avenue".

Estimated costs:

- RTA Rapid to Downtown:  
**\$1.50 per adult**, (kid under 3 free)  
**3 children aged 6-15 for \$1.00**

**Get a "transfer" coupon good for 1<sup>1/2</sup> hrs. so that you can ride the Lakefront Line later at no cost.**

- Terminal Tower observation deck:  
**\$2.00 / Adult, \$1.00 / child**

- RTA HomeBound: Same as in-bound (**\$1.50, 3/\$1.00**). "Transfers" with Homebound RTA fees paid at the Lakefront Line have a 4 hr. time limit so you can shop or see sights on the way home.
