AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Municipality of Powell River urge the Government of Canada to join with other states in military sanctions against Iraq only under the auspices of the United Nations and according to United Nations resolutions;

AND THAT a copy of this motion be circulated to the Federation of Canadian Municipalities, the Union of British Columbia Municipalities member municipalities and the local Members of Parliament."
