We have no electricity from the city, but we have a generator which runs almost all the time. From our roof, I can see much of the city and the Tigris River. Also, of course we see all the militia and army tanks and guards. It is kind-of neat, we have a guard of our own that lives in a shack outside our house. He walks us to and from our office which is about 2 blocks away.

We have no freedom to shop in town, so we send a driver to get milk, bread and whatever we need for the day. My mom says she can make it because they have coke.

Me myself, I home school. Since I don't have a lot of friends I take in homeless and abandoned pets that need a good loving owner. I have had baby kittens, a hedgehog and birds. At this moment I have 4 puppies and they are SO cute!!! But not to the Iraqis!! * Laugh out loud *

I like living here; I think I am the only 12 year old American in Baghdad. The office employees treat me special.

On special occasions, we travel into the *Green Zone*, this is the military zone. Nothing like the states, I am sure. They have a coffee shop, PX with only junk food, a Burger King, Pizza Inn, and a Subway. Of course these are only little trailers, so we get our food and go home.

I love to travel, even though I have been in Iraq 3 months we travel a bunch. We have been to Germany, Jordan, and the North Iraq to Kurdistan. I have been to many places that are really Historical and cool to hear about...In Jordan we went to the Dead Sea and swam there for a few hours and we literally FLOATED!!! It was awesome! and Mt. Nebo and Roman Ruins.

We went to Germany for Annual Meeting and I have made a lot of new friends from Israel, London and Jordan and more places that I think is really cool...

In Germany we went to visit Castles and Christmas town, on the Rhine. And the youth group went to Mainz and it not pronounced the way it's spelled its pronounced (Mintz.)
