Catcher: Baker, Buck, 1st base: Gload, Nomar

2nd base: Grudzielanek, Uribe, Sean Rodriguez Shortstop: Zobrist, Uribe. Wood, Hairston 3rd base: LaRoche, Wood, Uribe, Alb. Gonzalez

Left Field: Lee, Hairston

Center Field: Rowand, Edmonds, Gardner Right Field: Hart, Hairston, Edmonds DH: Bruce, Anderson, Gardner

Offensive strategies:

Stealing: Our preference is to Hit and Run before the 7th and consider a straight steal fom the 7th inning on. Hart, Hairston and Gardner are the main threats and can attempt a steal of second with COL -2 to +3 and the adjusted SSN is higher than 26.

Hit and Run: See Hit and Run designations in lineups above.

Pinch Hitting: Bruce and Edmonds will be the main choices vs RHP. Garciaparra vs. LHP.

Pinch Running: Gardner is the guy to turn to in game winning situations and will most likely be looking to steal second when he gets in the game.

Baserunning Advancement Guidelines:

Board Game: Runners whose chances to advance exceed the quidelines below should try for the next base. Otherwise, hold.

Computer Game:

All runners who are "well-around" should attempt to advance.

Send fast runners (speed 15+) who are merely "rounding" a base. Hold all others.

Defensive Strategies:

Defensive Replacements: If you need to PH or PR, use your judgment to get the best defense afterwards.

Holding Runner at 1st: Never if score is +/-5. Otherwise:

PL At bat: Always hold

PR or SA At Bat: Hold runners with adjusted SSN of 25+

Infield: Infield always deep unless tying or go-ahead run is on third with less than two outs in the 8th inning or later.

Outfield Throws:

Board Game: Outfielders should be throwing at all lead runners trying to advance with less than 33/36 chances <u>unless</u> tying/go-ahead run is trying to score in the 8th inning or later in which case throw for lead runner regardless of chances.

Computer Game: If the runner is "well around", don't throw unless tying/go-ahead run is trying to score in the 8th inning or later.

Pitching Strategy:

Starting Pitching:

Wandy, Unit, Slowey and Eveland – generally we'd like to see them reach their fatigue limits, but if they downgraded before then and the game is within reach (down 3 or less), then look to the pen.

Arroyo and Sonnanstine – They have a little shorter leash. If they make it to the 6th without being downgraded and the game is within 3 either way, then go to the pen. If they fall behind by five or more, then staple them to the mound until pounded out since it's unlikely the Jets offense will overcome such a deficit.

Relief Pitching: When the starter is forced to leave, here's the plan:

"Closer": It'll be a combination of Grilli, Cordero and Carlyle with Grilli's peripherals giving him the edge. Use them in the 8th and 9th innings with COL -2 to +3.

RH Set Up: Green, Gordon, Robertson and Condrey will fill this role and pitch in the 5th through 7th. LH Set Up: Let's see......that would be nobody.

Middle Relief/Mop Up: O'Day will take the brunt of mop-up duty. Use him when you downgrade the starter early. Limit him to 2.2 innings per appearance unless the next day is an off day. After that, spread the pain among the set-up guys.
