# **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

## **PITCHING**

## \*NO STARTER GOES LONGER THAN 11.2 INNINGS\*

Try to get 6 innings from all starters. In the  $6^{th}$  when score is -2/+3 and one run has scored go to the pen,  $7^{th}$  inning when first runner gets in scoring position go to the pen. Exception is **Young** who pitches until of course fatigued. The bullpen has enough innings but is not strong.

Any starter pitching a shutout stays in until he is scored on.

## **RELIEVERS**:

B.J. Ryan is the closer. He pitches in save situations only. Bennett is the alternate closer and set up pitcher from the 7<sup>th</sup> inning on.

Rapada, Castillo and Wuertz are the late inning relief pitchers. They can come in to pitch in the 6<sup>th</sup>, 7th and or 8<sup>th</sup> inning. At least 1 will be up each month. They may be brought in earlier if the middle men can't hold the lead or have to come out of the game.

Burnett, Rupe and Villarreal are the middle relievers. They can pitch from the 3<sup>rd</sup> inning through the 6<sup>th</sup>.

Jo. Peralta is the early relief pitcher. He can pitch in blow out situations, from the 1<sup>st</sup> inning on. He can also be used late in the game when the starter has fatigued and the lead is 5 or more runs. If the lead shrinks to 3 runs or less then bring in the usual set up pitchers or the closer.

### BASE RUNNING/STEALING

All (F) players will try for the extra base. Send runners in the  $1^{st}$ - $3^{rd}$  inning when adjusted number is 27+, in the  $4^{th}$ - $6^{th}$  inning adjusted number 26+, in the  $7^{th}$  inning through the end of game adjusted number 24+. Any question or doubt, consult the Adams chart. In the computer game send any runner who is "well around" the base.

## **STEALING**

No steal attempts when behind or ahead by 4 or more runs G. Blanco and W. Harris are the most eligible runners. Use the steal any time to get the game tying or go ahead run into scoring position from 7<sup>th</sup> inning on. Also see Hit and Run.

#### HIT AND RUN

The players doing the running can only be: W. Harris and G. Blanco. I prefer this option over the straight steal but with this team there won't be a lot of either this year.

### **DEFENSE**

Hold all (F) runners with less than two outs. Do not hold any player who can not steal. In the 1<sup>st</sup> thru 6<sup>th</sup> inning play the infield deep to go for double play From the 7<sup>th</sup> inning on play the infield in to try and cut off any runs to keep the score within +3 or -3 runs.

Always use the highest rated player as replacement in case of injury or pinch hit.

## **SACRIFICE**

Sacrifice from the 6<sup>th</sup> inning or later to get the game tying or winning run into scoring position.

Anyone can sacrifice.

## **NO SQUEEZE PLAYS**

## PINCH HITTING/PINCH RUNNING

Pinch hit from the 8<sup>th</sup> inning on when the game tying or winning run is in scoring position. Use best available batter off the bench who puts pitcher at greatest disadvantage.

Pinch runner should be an (F). Use any available position player first then any (F) starting pitcher. There may be times when an (F) is not available as most will already be in the starting line up. If that's the case then use the highest speed available. Only pinch run when it represents the game tying or winning run.
