

BILLY YOU'RE SUCH AN ASSHOLE

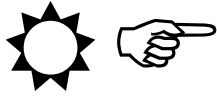
[INTRO]

Billy, you're just an asshole, don't visit me!



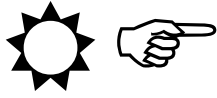
BILLY YOU'RE SUCH AN ASSHOLE
