

How to make this your default Internet Home Page:

Microsoft Internet Explorer and Neoplanet for
Windows

Internet Explorer for Macintosh

Netscape Navigator 2.x or 3.x

To make this your default internet home page in Internet Explorer and Neoplanet for Windows 95 and 98:
Go to the Start Menu, Settings, and Control panel.



Then, when the control panel opens, double-click the icon labeled Internet Options.



Then, in the dialog that appears, where it says home page, type in <http://sites.netscape.net/hieberaaron>.



Now, click OK and you are done!

In Netscape Navigator 2.x and 3.x for Windows and
Macintosh:

Go to the Options menu, and choose General Preferences.
In that box, there should be something labeled Home Page.
In that box, type <http://sites.netscape.net/hieberaaron>. Then
click Ok and you are done!

In Netscape Navigator and Communicator 4.x for Windows
and Macintosh:

In the edit menu, go to preferences. Then, in the dialog that
appears, there should be an option called Home Page. In it,
type <http://sites.netscape.net/hieberaaron>. Then click OK
and you are done!

In Microsoft Internet Explorer for Macintosh:
Click the option on the toolbar labeled Options. Then, in
the box that appears, in the place where you type the home
page address, type <http://sites.netscape.net/hieberaaron>.
Click OK and you are done!
