

The End Low Pay Campaign presented the Scrooge of the Year Award 2002 to George Bain at Christmas. Mr Bain was the person responsible for recommending the low level of the minimum wage and the loopholes in the legislation that allow employers to avoid paying the minimum wage. He also deserved the award for his report which opposed fair pay for the firefighters and his proposals for the destruction of the fire service as we know it.

But Mr Bain was not the only contender. We have received the names of dozens of new employers paying miserly wages eg. apprentice electricians on $\pounds 1.75$ per hour, one Costcutters shop pays $\pounds 2.10$ to under 18s, and hairdressers on $\pounds 1.75$ an hour! The End Low Pay Campaign will stepping up our campaign of exposing low pay employers and plan to picket them.

End Low Pay Campaign

The current minimum wage of £4.20 is an insult. In the five years since it was introduced, the minimum wage has gone up a miserly 60p. Youth exemptions allow employers to exploit young workers. For under 18s there is no minimum. 18-21 year olds get £3.60. We want youth exemptions abolished. We are demanding £6 minimum NOW. Join the End low Pay Campaign today!

- + Trade union rights for all. Scrap the anti-union laws
- + A 35 hour working week without loss of pay to create thousands of
