#### **End Low Pay Campaign**

The minimum wage is currently £4.50 per hour for workers aged 22 and over, £3.80 per hour for those aged between 18 and 21 and for under 18s there is no minimum wage. We want youth exemptions abolished. We are demanding £6 minimum NOW.

- If you don't get proper payslips
- If you do not have breaks, holiday pay or other basic entitlements get in touch with us.
