Palm Sunday (March 23/4)

Masses:

Saturday 5:00 p.m.

Sunday 8:00 a.m., 9:30 a.m. (Sung English), 11:00 a.m. (Sung Novus Ordo Latin)

Nota Bene: 1:00 p.m., 8:00 p.m.

Solemn Vespers and Benediction on Sunday at 5:00 p.m.

Confessions for 15 minutes before all Masses and from 4:00 - 5:00 p.m. on Saturday.

Blessed Palms will be available at all Masses. Processions with singing at the 9:30 and 11:00 a.m.

Masses. The Passion will be sung in Latin at the 11:00 a.m. Mass.

Monday, March 25 to Wednesday, March 27

Masses (as usual) at 7:45 a.m., 11:30 a.m., and 5:30 p.m.

A special service of sacred music and Compline will take place on Wednesday at 8:00 p.m.

Holy Thursday (March 28)

There are no Masses during the day, but the church will be open.

Confessions: 5:00 - 6:00 p.m., 7:00 - 7:45 p.m., and after the Mass of the Lord's Supper until midnight.

Mass of the Lord's Supper: 8:00 p.m. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament until midnight.

Pabasa begins in the parish hall after the Mass and continues until 3:00 p.m. Friday.

Good Friday (March 29)

(This is a day of fast and abstinence.)

There is no Mass today, but the church will be open.

Confessions: 2:00 - 3:00 p.m. and during Stations of the Cross.

Liturgy of the Passion: 3:00 p.m.

Stations of the Cross at 7:30 p.m. followed by veneration of a relic of the True Cross.

Holy Saturday (March 30)

There is no morning or afternoon Mass today, but the church will be open.

Confessions: 4:00 - 5:00 p.m. and 8:00 - 8:45 p.m.

Easter Vigil: 9:00 p.m. (This Mass fulfills the Sunday obligation.)

Easter Sunday (March 31)

Masses at: 8:00 a.m., 9:30 a.m. (Sung English), 11:00 a.m. (Sung Novus Ordo Latin)

12:30 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.

Solemn Vespers and Benediction on Sunday at 5:00 p.m.

Easter Monday (April 1)

Masses today will be at 10:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

The regular weekday schedule of Masses and Confessions resumes on Tuesday, April 2. The whole week, from Easter Sunday until Sunday, April 7 (inclusive) is known as the Easter Octave. Each day is a solemnity.
