

1. TOURNAMENT IS LIMITED ONLY TO YABA SANCTIONED LEAGUES BOWLER AND HIGH SCHOOL LEAGUES FROM THIS CURRENT SEASON. AGE LIMIT IS 20 YEARS OLD. NO COLLEGIATE BOWLERS ABOVE 20 YEARS WILL BE ACCEPTED. PARTICIPATION FEE OF \$2.00 FOR NON-YABA MEMBERS.
2. DRESS CODE: BOWLERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO WEAR A SHIRT OF BLOUSE, SLACKS, SKIRT, COULOTTLES MAY BE WORN. NO SHORTS, NO HEAD ATTIRE. DIRECTORS HAVE FINAL DECISION ON ATTIRE NOT DEEMED PROPER.
3. NO DEROGATORY CONDUCT, FOUL LANGUAGE, OR DELIBERATE KICKING OF BALL RETURN. IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION FROM TOURNAMENT WILL RESULT.
4. ALL YABA TOURNAMENT RULES WILL PREVAIL.
5. YABA & IHSA RULES WILL APPLY ON ALL SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDS. SCHOLARSHIP MONEY WILL BE SENT DIRECTLY TO SCHOOL.
6. NO MORE THAN SIX BOWLERS ON A PAIR OF LANES.
7. HANDICAP IS 90% OF THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN AVERAGE AND 200, BASED ON BOWLERS HIGHEST LEAGUE AVERAGE, ON JANUARY 28, 2002. BOWLERS MUST HAVE BOWLED AT LEAST 12 GAMES TO ESTABLISH AN AVERAGE. SUMMER LEAGUE AVERAGE NOT VALID. ENTRANT MUST LIST HIGHEST AVERAGE BOWLED IN ANY LEAGUE IN WHICH THEY PARTICIPATED IN THE 2000-2001 SEASON. IF FINAL AVERAGE FOR 2000-2001 WAS 10 PINS HIGHER THAN THEIR ENTERING AVERAGE A COMBINED AVERAGE WILL BE USED.
8. FORMAT: 4-GAMES ACROSS 8-LANES. FIELD WILL BE CUT TO TOP 4 IN EACH DIVISION, BASED TOTAL SERIES WITH HANDICAP. TOP 4 FINALISTS WILL BE SEEDED AND BOWL HEAD TO HEAD MATCHES WITH HANDICAP. 1 VS 4, 2 VS 3. THIS FORMAT WILL BE FOLLOWED UNTIL CHAMPION HAS BEEN DETERMINED.
9. RE-ENTER PERMITTED, BASED ON LANE AVAILABILITY.
10. SCHOLARSHIP'S AWARDED WILL BE AT LEAST ONE AWARD PER EACH TEN ENTRIES IN EACH DIVISION.
11. FINAL CLOSING DATE IS LAST SQUAD.
