Patch 1

<u>Patchname:</u> 513.SpiritualSphere <u>Type of patch:</u> OS 1.2 Tony: This is a more atmospheric version of the spiritual delays program, with the tap delay through detune plex, enjoy <u>Made by:</u> Tony from Norway alias jfaen777 <u>Effectblocks</u> A: M_chorustaps B: Detune4plex

Review Arjen: usable for: roomy (pingpong) delays Used external connection: Eclipse in analog fx loop Ideas for external modulation/controllers: Whats great: good hotkeys usage, very usable for vocal endings Points to improve: no suggestions

Review Tom from France:

<u>usable for:</u> "Atmospheric" is the quite right term, but Tony could have used "Stratospheric" too ! Very wide and long sound with taps "in the mist". I use it with the "violoning"

technique.Reminds me of some Eric Johnson songs (like the beginning of "Venus Rose"). <u>Used external connection:</u> Eclipse between Tri Axis and Power Amp

Ideas for external modulation/controllers: I changed the Tap Tempo with ext controller : at high BPM rates, you don't notice the taps no more, this sounds like the bridge in the Dream Theatre song "New Millenium". But at small rates, you can get real cool stuff scratching your pick on the strings, sounds like "nightmare background sounds" in scary movies ... Whats great:

<u>usable for:</u> some great gitar effects <u>Used external connection:</u> Eclipse in my recording setup/my old rusty gitar... <u>Ideas for external modulation/controllers</u>: none <u>Whats great:</u> The gitarsound , just plain gorgeous, the best patch of the review this time, should be inside the new OS. Do not need to say more.... Points to improve: none

Patchname: 520Shimmer <u>Type of patch:</u> O.S. 1.2 This is a delay run in parallel with a reverse plex to get a U2 "Shimmer" kinda sound. OS 2.0. I built it running straight into the eclipse then into a Vox. YMMV! <u>Made by:</u> Sean Moran alias japanmoran <u>Effectblocks</u> A: Moddelays+verbs B:reverse4plex

Review Arjen:

<u>usable for:</u> Fat delays, U2/eighties kinda sounds <u>Used external connection:</u> Eclipse in analog fx loop <u>Ideas for external modulation/controllers</u>: <u>Whats great:</u> comes very close to U2, hotkeys on second page (nice one) <u>Points to improve:</u> 'ringing' can be a bit annoying, I'd prefer some tempo sync in hotkeys area

Review Tom from France:

<u>usable for:</u> I tweaked it to use it as my verse sound on the U2 song "New Year's Day" ... Reminds me of some Rush effects, too <u>Used external connection:</u> Eclipse between Tri Axis and Power Amp <u>Ideas for external modulation/controllers</u>: I set a pedal to change the decay % of the master reverse 4 plex. (from 90 % to -30 %). Makes the plex sounds more-or-less noticeable. <u>Whats great:</u> <u>Points to improve</u>:

<u>usable for:</u> gitar like U2

Used external connection: Eclipse in my recording setup/my old rusty gitar...

Ideas for external modulation/controllers: none

<u>Whats great:</u> nice patch for a starter Sean, also nice for the audience seeing you making the magic with a touch of the pedal.

<u>Points to improve</u>: the magic (reverse4plex) could use some more panning. It makes the sound even better.

Patchname: In a distance <u>Type of patch:</u> Os 1.101 Guitars love this one. Very sweet airy effect.OS 1.20 <u>Made by:</u> Laurent alias snapshotfr <u>Effectblocks</u> A: reverce chrystals B: Reverb8

Review Arjen: <u>usable for:</u> weird spacy stuff <u>Used external connection:</u> Eclipse in analog fx loop <u>Ideas for external modulation/controllers</u>: <u>Whats great:</u> nice effect to play with for hours ;-) Points to improve: no suggestions

Review Tom from France:

<u>usable for:</u> very very long delay time. I almost can't remember what I played when the sound finally comes ! I changed the routing to "Parallel", set the FXA Mix to 40 %, and now I can hear my guitar, with still those chipmunks sounds at the end of my lick ...Maybe usable for some early Steve Vai stuff ! <u>Used external connection:</u> Eclipse between Tri Axis and Power Amp <u>Ideas for external modulation/controllers</u>: ? <u>Whats great:</u>

Points to improve:

<u>usable for:</u> lot of crazy effects <u>Used external connection:</u> Eclipse in my recording setup/my old rusty gitar... <u>Ideas for external modulation/controllers</u>: <u>Whats great:</u> For the ambient feel inside a busy composition, put in a low E on your gitar, set pitch 2 to -500 and you get a large boat in the harbor of Rotterdam! Points to improve: none

Patchname: StereoFattener Type of patch: Stereo Fattener that can be used on practically everything to give it more 'room' or 'air' OS v1.200 Made by: Arjen alias ahalewijn Effectblocks A: Delay8plex

Review Tom from France:

<u>usable for:</u> For those who want to feel an "in your face" room with no reverberation at all (I mean, once you've played and you cut off your volume knob, there's no delay). Close that door ! <u>Used external connection:</u> Eclipse between Tri Axis and Power Amp <u>Ideas for external modulation/controllers</u>: <u>Whats great:</u> Points to improve:

Review Harrie:

<u>usable for:</u> gitars, drums, vocals, use it for fattening and get a little distance in the sound. <u>Used external connection:</u> Eclipse in my recording setup/my old rusty gitar... <u>Ideas for external modulation/controllers</u>: FX B is free for putting a longer delay, controlled by a pedal. This could make a solo sound and using FX A for the normal sound. Or you couls use the midi output of the POD-Pro for playing it live.

<u>Whats great:</u> Fattening everything and stereoize. Nice one. Lot of rooms and round sound. Usefull for fattening drums.

Points to improve: just a very nice patch. Maybe a little more modulation/pitch-shifting to give it the sparkle of the patch tony made.

Patch 5

Patchname: Waterverb Type of patch: Waterverb, Korn like chorus, use it on clean gitar, OS1.200 Made by: Harrie Munnik alias studiofroombosch Effectblocks A: Stereo chorus delay B: Reverb8

Review Arjen:

usable for: sounds that need fast chorusses or whuzzing and whoopying like Blake's Seven (does anyone remember? Old scifi series) Used external connection: Eclipse in analog fx loop Ideas for external modulation/controllers: speed Whats great: verb level indepent for L/R channel under one hotkey Points to improve: could use more hotkeys

Review Tom from France:

usable for: Could sound like the keyboard on Led Zeppelin "No quarter" beginning. But then some chorus would be lacking. As soon as I get some time, I try to work on a "No quarter sound" based on "waterveb" !

Used external connection: Eclipse between Tri Axis and Power Amp Ideas for external modulation/controllers:

Whats great: The use of Hotkey ! 'Cause putting the fxb mix as an hotkey is smart ! But then changing the "feedback" name in "warble" is not kind with you fellow reviewer that has to find out what this strange parameter is !! Points to improve:
