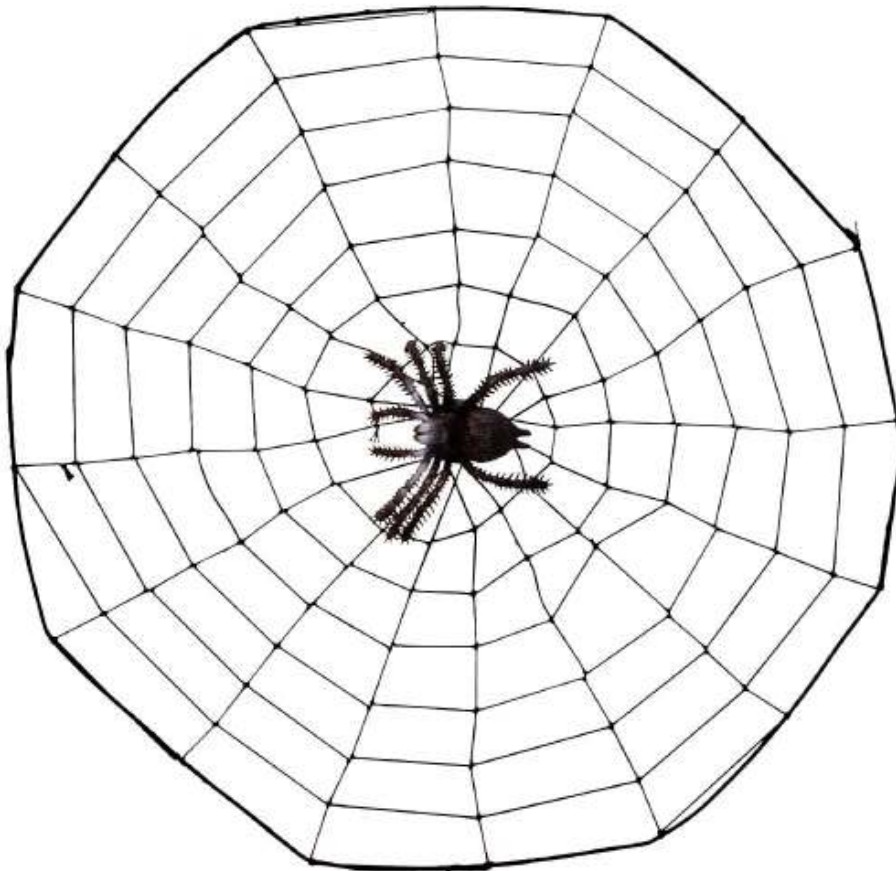

Business Meeting

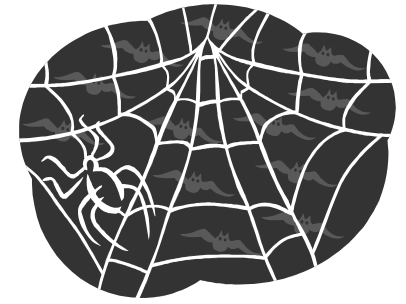

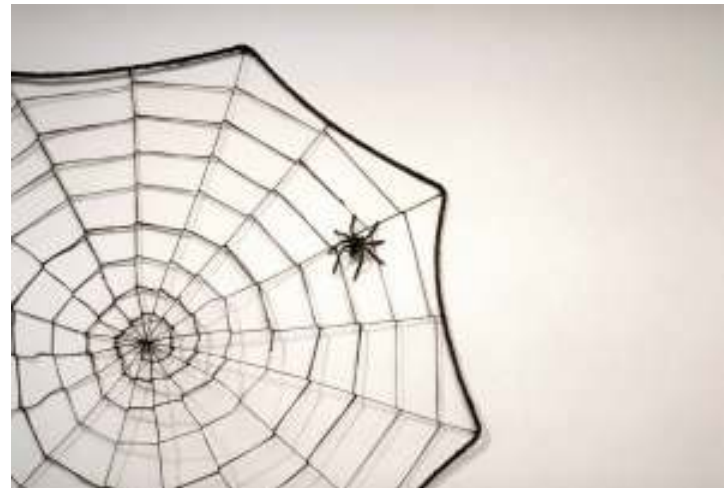
