

When we read our Club's mission statement, it is immediately obvious that one person cannot create a club atmosphere. It takes the whole team. If we could develop communication and leadership skills in front of our bathroom mirror we would not need Toastmasters. We need the Team and we need teamwork to achieve our goals.

As a team we need to:

A. Define the team

 a. The team consists of Superiorland Toastmasters membership. Each member has a part to play in the achievement of our club goals. It takes teamwork.

B. Articulate our objectives

a. Our ultimate goal is the President's Distinguished Club in 2004-05. Every member on our team needs to have the same goal. And we need to stay on the same page in accomplishing those goals. It takes teamwork.

C. Define a plan

a. Every member is important. Every member must be active in some part of the club environment. What is your goal for this meeting, this month, this year? We need to work together, and add up our accomplishments to reach our goal. It takes teamwork.

D. Be Accountable

a. Every member is accountable for the behaviors

that will help the team achieve their objective. Every active member that is working towards the next award, that is attending meetings, that is taking a role, that is holding an office, that pays their dues on time, and is supportive of other members is fulfilling their part of the plan. It takes teamwork.

It cannot be done alone. The Club's Executive Board needs to hear your voice. It is not the Board's club; it is the member's club. If you have an issue, a concern, a goal or an idea — it is your responsibility to communicate those thoughts with a Board member. In a football game when all the players are on the same page in the playbook, they can work together to score the goal. The same is true with our Club. We all need to be on the same page. Speak up. Remember, it takes teamwork and we are all members of the same team.
