- Class 3 12 years & under (Novice) Combination not to have been placed 1st–6th at an equivalent height or higher in an ODE (excluding THPC and TVH mini/novice ODEs) Dressage test: Pony Club Introductory 2007 Fences not exceeding 70cm with 'L' options.
- Class 4 14 years & under (Novice) Combination not to have been placed 1st–6th at an equivalent height or higher in an ODE (excluding THPC and TVH mini/novice ODEs) Dressage test: Pony Club Introductory 2007 Fences not exceeding 70cm.
- Class 4a Open Novice Combination not to have been placed 1st–6th at an equivalent height or higher in an ODE (excluding THPC and TVH mini/novice ODEs) Dressage test: Pony Club Introductory 2007 Fences not exceeding 70cm. Class may be split according to entries.

Entry Fee for ODE (classes 1–4) £20.00 (£14.00 for Tiverton Hunt Pony Club members)

Rosettes to 6th place in all classes. Rosette for Best Dressage and Best Tiverton Member in each class.

The organiser has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all the officials and stewards

<u>Rules</u>

- A protective helmet with a cover must be worn at all times when mounted which complies with safety standards as set out in Pony Club Rules. (PC members should have their hats tagged). Examples of approved labels are PAS015:1998; BS EN 1384: 1997 or 1996; AS/NZS3838 1998 or 2003. Further details from secretary.
- 2. Medical Armbands are recommended at all times and are compulsory for Cross Country. A few may be available for purchase on the day
- 3. In Class 1, in which ponies may be led in the Show Jumping and Cross Country phases, only one person may assist each rider while on the course.
- 4. Competitors must report to stewards, mounted, for each phase, 10 minutes before they are due to ride. There will be a tack check before the dressage phase.
- 5. Ages as on 1st January 2009.
- 6. The committee reserve the right to refuse any entry.
- 7. Entries refunded before closing date. No entries refunded after closing date.
- 8. The judges' decision is final.
- 9 Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- 10. All classes, and all phases, may be ridden in any normal riding bit. Martingales are not allowed in the dressage phase. More detailed rules concerning dress and tack will be posted with the secretary on the day.
