- D- Math must be correct or the Adjutant will return for correction.
- E- Complete the Captain, Company, Regt, Station (location) with actual information. Use actual date of the month but the year can be reported as 18--.
- F- Form must be signed by both the 1st Sgt and the Captain or the Adjutant will return for correction
- G- Keep a record so you can provide "yesterdays" count
