Matt Humphrey was the prodigal drummer for Victory Gin and has, after a hiatus, has decided to grace Tomorrow Comes Crashing with his skills.

Their performance and music has been compared to the likes of Braid, Sunny Day Real Estate and Coheed and Cambria.
