We will call the parents when we are close to our destination. The pick up spot will be at the Red Lock parking area of the Towpath. This is off of Vaughn Road almost directly across the entrance to Brandywine Ski Center. The boys should have sturdy boots or hiking shoes. They should have a full backpack (external frame or internal frame but not a daypack) but only filled partially. The weight should not exceed twenty pounds, and it should not be too bulky. Rain gear, personal first aid kit, extra shirt n socks, snacks, and plenty of water should be packed. Two Quarts of water should be taken. This is about 4 lbs., so if you want to add more weight you can add more water. We are scheduled for Saturday morning but might switch to Sunday so we have our full crew on the hike.
