2007-2008 Scout Goals

- Scouts First Class and above Start/Finish at least two Eagle required merit badges
- Every scout below First Class advances to First Class within one year
- Every outing will incorporate older scout activity's for a portion of the day
- The troop will have two service projects per semester
- Finish higher priority activity's at the meeting faster to play more games
- Scouts know their positions and how to carry them out
- Each scout sets at least one fitness goal and achieves it each semester (Physically Strong)
- Each scout reads at least one book each year (Mentally Strong) Reading list kept by Librarian

2008 potential Summer Long Term/High Adventure Events:

- High Adventure/long term outing:

- Green River Canoeing – \$300 to \$400 per person for 5 days/4 nights canoeing, 7 day/6 night total for trip
- **Florida Sea Base – sailing, fishing, outer island options. Estimate \$1200 per person for 7 day/6 night adventure**
- Northern Tier Canoe Trek - \$600-\$700 per person 7 day 6 night trek plus 2 days ground travel each way. Add \$200-300 if air transport used instead of ground
- Denver Area Council Tahosa High adventure base- tailorable backpacking trek 5 to 8 days

- 5) Ben Delatour (Longs Peak Council, Fort Collins, CO, \$170-\$225, depending on program) – offers C.O.P.E. for adults and older scouts. Lake only, no pool
