

Battle Hill - the rideofn hell?

The ridewas later in theyear than usual, which rowided twin benefits of letter footing in the drier condition and fitter horses. Lastyear Iremember struggling bound feeling utterly exhausted at the end, especially after the "goows lover the 20 river crossings, then the catch up" be a proved to be a hill ath went onforever. This year the river rossings seemed much less traumatic, though I head of two rides who nearly fell in a chol and one whose hose refused to jump dallen log util given some serious disciplie. The ridewas what I used think CTR rides were all about; ots of challenges, some had hill climb, wonderful views and dts of room for thingsto go wong. As it happened, all the ride rode to the conditions and the were very few vet outs.

It began with a longatfl idealfor for warming up, then a loop around farmland, before cossing Transmission Gully. Then itwas onward and pward largely through pineforest which potected from both sun and wind fore winding dwn through a rack which was laced with springs and with to the reek. The river or creek cossings were sbw but dvely riding and then witas back to thetop again and oto loggingroads before the final decline back to Transmission Gully.

For me, the biggest challengevas going out accss Transmission Gully, Iwas tagging along with Denise and ylene, whowent into what they called a controlled canter." Sarlight Express decided itwas an outof control gallop which indated the need for a little odeo exercise. I am ot that keen on that sortof thing, so insteadof liftingmy heels highto art maximum poits, I dug themnto her sideto tryto cling on. Tat, she thought, was encouragement to buck hader. When shean outof steam and I managedo haul her head uporfn between her less my saddle was sitting nearly on herrealn the true spirit CTR, Denise and Raylene (who hadby this time ranished down to the reek) came backto see if was alright. Iwas really grateful but itwas going to take me 10 minutes o sort out (the hee preferably when they weren't looking) the saddle sctold them to go on.Ten to 15 minutesater Iwas back on bord with a suitably repentant animal - who then oshed what Arabs are all about, she justrotted steadily and ederminedly up that hill till she caught up. After having high heartates at Mt Cecil, was a little concerned about all thisfort butfor somereason my horse coped better (maybe because of that stallion).

Despite these little ediances from the norm, it was one of the most enjoyable rides of the seasorfor me. Cetting the time

right was a little challenging and atapulted down the last hill of the Plaetiro Loopat therate of knots, along with end or soother riders we picked up along the ay. My saddle has a tendency to slip and rather hoped that this wouldn't happen as we were careering round a hairpin bend with a diffit to the right. Everyone got to the bottom safely and some ook off into the distance to atch up time.

Each ride in the season seettors be better than the one foure. Good weather helps. Battle Hill seemedo run kie clockwork, no onewould have guessedat all thework that went on before. Julia Bryce fom Lakeside Vets was very complimatary about the organisation. Once again that to all the ride helpse (someof whom had a littleecognition for the Clubrofm Father Christmas today).
