Pre ride entries...

Ring me aytime before the rid, upto 9pm – 04 237 8122. I willtake your entry and assignyou a bib number and a time out. Please accept the bib number given, kesmdoingresults much easier if thy are given out inroter. Please also dive your registration numbers ready.

At the rie, there will be aolo withyour bib in it, and in rehe's a folder withyour entry form, vet card, and ride certifacte. Collect these, then go to the entry person taking payment, pay and you are all done. Entries now has a timerafne. Entries openat 7:30am and close at 9am. For rewcomers who do out know this, an exception will be made THE REST TIME if thy arrive atte.

Everybody please fill out albur forms IN FULL. You have registration numbers, PLEASE put them on theory form. It makes my job much easing as I also type up the fulls afterwards.

When you have filled out/our forms, you then goto the pisson taking payment. Go there first and pay and git your bb. THEN bring your vet card to the time out pson (usually me)to get your time out. More sure it gits written oneyour vet card. Your time due is your own responsibility to work out.

Early start times rbm 8:30to 9am is alloated to Opens and Intermediates only. They may start later if they want, but because they have the geatest distance and the longest ride tisnethey get this fist half hourto themselves. Warehouse Grain, Juniors and Novices leave from 9:05am. Any questions please phone em
