After lunch to 5 p.m. (closing) ~ Enjoy the Seaport's exhibits; a 1/2-hour cruise on the Steamship *Sabino* (\$5.50/ person not included); visit the Planetarium (\$2.50 /person); the Research Library (reservations required & if staff involvement, there may be a fee); or the Maritime Art Gallery (no charge)



The centerpiece of Mystic Seaport is the *Charles W. Morgan*, the last wooden whale ship in the world, currently in the beginning phase of a \$5 million three-year restoration voyage.

Launched out of New Bedford, MA, in 1841, the *Morgan* sailed the oceans and seas of the world in search of whale oil, baleen and ambergris. After 37 voyages, the *Morgan* was laid up in 1921, after which she was exhibited at the Colonel Green Estate at Round Hill in South Dartmouth until 1941. In November of that year, after extensive local efforts to maintain the ship failed, the decision was made to tow her to Mystic Seaport. Battered by the 1938 hurricane and years of disuse, she almost sank in the Mystic River before reaching the sand and gravel berth that was to be her home in subsequent years.
