### Wilde Lake High School CONCERT BAND Syllabus 2007 – 08

Concert Band is an ensemble open to all students with previous experience on a musical instrument. The ensemble will perform music of the late Renaissance period through this current century. Emphasis is on individual as well as ensemble playing. Students showing significant ability and improvements can move into the Wind Ensemble. The group will perform concerts at school as well as throughout the district. Students will also have the opportunity to participate in overnight trips. Those wishing to begin a band instrument can do so in this ensemble.

STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO PRACTICE OUTSIDE OF CLASS. STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO ATTEND A SECTIONAL. Sectionals meet one period every other week in addition to the full rehearsals. Sectionals will take place during periods 2 and 6. To try and ensure all students' participation in sectionals, there will be a make-up sectional offered on Thursday after school from 2:15 pm to 3:00 pm. Students unable to attend their regularly scheduled sectional or the school day make-up on Friday should attend this Thursday afternoon sectional. No students should miss sectional lessons with this increased opportunity. The specific sectional allows for smaller group work and more individual help to students. In sectionals, difficult passages are worked out so that full ensemble time can be used to develop the overall sound and blend of the ensemble. Students will miss class for sectionals on a rotating basis and are responsible for making up any missed class work. Grading is done by individual performance of assigned materials on a quarterly basis.

Note: Private lessons enhance a student's performing ability. Many fine, private teachers are available in this area. If not currently studying privately, students are encouraged to take advantage of this enriching opportunity. Names are available from the band web link found at <u>www.wildelake.com</u>.

Listed below is the Band Code of Conduct, which all members are expected to

adopt.

- 1. Show respect for your fellow musicians and director.
- 2. Be on time for class. Three tardies equal one detention. After that office referrals will be given, and school administrative policies will be enforced.
- 3. Enter the bandroom promptly, take out instrument, and take seat quickly.
- 4. No congregating in instrument storage room before class.
- 5. Students will not talk when the director is giving instructions.
- 6. Raise your hand when asking a question; it will always be answered.
- 7. Students need to practice and put forth an effort to improve.
- 8. Band is fun; enjoy it.
- 9. A student's individual adherence to this code will be factored into the quarterly grade.

#### **IMPORTANT NOTE: Concert Band Requirement**

The daily Concert Band rehearsals will <u>not</u> include the percussion section. In order to prepare for our performances, it will be necessary to have a **few** evening rehearsals prior to each performance. There are only a small number of evening rehearsals, but they are needed to combine the percussion section with the wind players. The dates and times are included in the enclosed calendar and are <u>mandatory</u> for everyone. Last year, several students missed the rehearsals due to work, forgetfulness, lack of transportation, and a myriad of other reasons. **This is not acceptable.** There are only a small number of rehearsals, and students must attend. Students missing these rehearsals will have their grade impacted.

### **GRADING POLICY**

Evaluation is done each quarter on performance of assigned material. Also factored into the exam grade will be an assessment of the student's daily behavior and his conformance to the Band Code of Conduct, attentiveness in class as well as <u>evidence</u> of progress and preparation through daily practice. There are several instances in which a student's grading will be severely impacted.

- 1. Missing a performance will result in the grade being lowered three letters. Written assignments may be given as deemed necessary.
- 2. If a student misses two sectionals in one marking period, the grade will be lowered one letter grade.
- **3.** Missing the District Band Adjudication will result in an "E" for the third quarter.
- 4. Missing an evening rehearsal will result in the grade being lowered one letter.
- 5. Failure to return medical form will result in an "E" in each quarter until received. A student cannot participate in any field trips until the form is returned.

The grading assessment will be scheduled as follows.

<u>October</u> First quarter playing exam Return medical form – **required of all students** 

<u>January</u> Mid-term exam Ensemble auditions for WLHS Band Program, 2008-09 <u>March</u> Third quarter playing exam

<u>May</u> Senior final playing exam Complete course evaluation (seniors)

<u>June</u> Final playing exam Complete course evaluation
