# South Conway Road Widening

Engineering is about 60% complete for the continued South Conway road widening project. Plans are slated to be complete by October 2003 with construction beginning when the right-of-ways are acquired—as early as spring, 2004.

The current plan eliminates the northbound turn onto Conway Road from Rothbury Drive. This elimination has been reviewed and approved by the City of Orlando along with consulting engineerings. Citing safety as the biggest issue, the elimination of the left-turn lane has been determined as the proper course of action.

If anyone has with problems or concerns regarding this issue, now is the time to speak up. After construction begins any changes will be unlikely. Charlyne Cross is working on a letter that will be made available for residents who wish to express their opinion on this matter.


