ARE YOU READY?

Hurricane Season is upon us! We have already had several named storms work their way around the State of Florida. Somewhere within the State or our Tri-County Area, someone has already experienced a Hurricane, Tornadoes or Funnel Clouds this season.

I know a lot of you have done extensive work on your homes or yards recovering from last season's storms. Just recently, I saw a neighbor up the street from me finally getting a new roof on the home.

I know many people have gone out to purchase hurricane supplies and generators. Some have even had hurricane shutters installed or have purchased the necessary supplies for when the time comes to board up their homes.

The Board has also completed repairs on the wells and tennis court and is looking at replacing the trees and shrubs lost to the hurricanes or plight of Citrus Canker.

Now is the time to take a good look around your property. Are you ready?

When walking the neighborhood I still see some remains from last summer's hurricanes of broken limbs and branches hanging from trees. That could be the flying object that goes through windows or pierces a roof! Take the time to get these removed and have your trees thinned out so they can best weather the high winds.

Look around your yard for that loose lumber, broken pots or planters, unsecured lawn tools or propane tanks. Check your fences to make sure that they are secured properly. Many times they have been installed only using one spike at all contact points. Check for other potential items that could become projectiles hitting your house or your neighbor's home.

As the Hurricane season kicked off this year we were all reminded of last summer's events and I'm sure everyone in this neighborhood does not want to experience the same thing this year. If it does happen, let's make sure we are doing everything possible to minimize our exposure.

If you receive a suspicious phone call during the night asking you to go outside your home for any reason......HANG UP immediately and look out a window or door peep hole to see if a strange person or car is in your driveway or at your door. Dial 911 to report the incident and ask that a deputy be dispatched to check the area. Several reports of such calls have been received by City Hall.
