The Computer Class of Wyandotte High School made available to the reunion planning committee our 1965 Quiverian on CD.

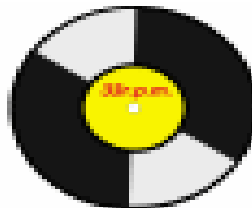
We have had a great response so far. Many have misplaced, lost, or have had their yearbooks destroyed over the years and were glad to be able to have it once again.
