\*\*\*\*\* **5 Band WAS Rules** \*\*\*\*\*

1. The 5BWAS certificate and plaque (see below #4) will be issued for having submitted confirmations with each of the 50 United States for contacts dated January 1, 1970, or after, on five amateur bands (10, 18 and 24 MHz excluded). Phone and CW segments of a band do not count as separate bands.
2. WAS Rules (MSD-264) that do not conflict with these 5BWAS rules also apply to the 5BWAS Award.
3. There are no specialty 5 Band awards or endorsements.
4. A handsome 9 X 12 personalized walnut plaque is available for a fee of \$30 US (check or money order) plus shipping (\$8 in USA).
5. The fee for the 5 Band WAS certificate is \$10, which includes a lapel pin.

\*\*\*\*\* **Directions to Applicant** \*\*\*\*\*

1. Read the 5BWAS rules above and WAS Rules (MSD-264) carefully.
2. Fill out BOTH sides of this application.
3. Sort cards by state as listed on the back of this form.
4. Present application and cards to your ARRL HF Awards Manager for verification. Applications from DX stations may be certified by the Awards Manager of your IARU member-society.
5. Send applications to ARRL HQ. Send cards ONLY if there is no local HF Awards Manager to verify your application.
6. If mailing cards, enclose the \$10 fee and sufficient postage for return of your cards. Typically, 250 QSL cards weigh 30 ounces. Mail to ARRL 5BWAS Award, 225 Main Street, Newington, CT 06111 USA
7. Enclose \$30 US plus shipping if you want the plaque. (\$8 shipping US, foreign depending on location)
