- **\$2**, see TWO DOLLARS.
- ❑ **13th Floor**, Team taking an elevator and unloading on the 13th floor. **300**
- ❑ **k 1999**, Team partying like it's 1999 (that's so last year). **100**
- **9 Yards**, see NINE YARDS.
- ❑ **M Abandoned Car Quest**, Team standing with an abandoned car. **150** each
- ❑ **K D Accounting Quest**, Video of a fixed asset. **100**
- ❑ **K M ACTION MOVIE**, Every team will need a small plastic action figure. The big budget, Arnold & Sly-style Hollywood production action movie starring this figurine must be between 1 and 2 minutes long. **600** (bonus points for style, for best)
- ❑ **Adult Store**, TM holding up something risqué at an adult store. **300**
- ❑ **Aerobics**, Team doing an aerobic workout (a formal routine) in a health club. **400**
- ❑ **Afraid, Very**, TM telling a stranger, "Be afraid, be very afraid." (disclaimer: It is considered bad manners to scare the shit out of your fellow man) **200**
- ❑ **Airplane**, TM flying a radio controlled airplane. **400**
- ❑ **K M D Alka-Seltzer**, TM drinking a cup of Alka-Seltzer. **250** (+**50** for team singing the jingle while TM drinks it)
- ❑ **Alt-Trans Quest**, Team's official Filmquest vehicle (defined as the vehicle in which a team spends 95% or more of their travel time) is something OTHER than a standard vehicle (car, pick-up, mini-van, SUV, jeep, etc.). Filmquest encourages alternative modes of transportation. **1000**
- ❑ **K D J Amazing Grace**, TM singing an a-capella gospel rendition of Amazing Grace (first verse only) in a public place with at least 20 strangers close enough to hear. **300** (+**250** if other TMs on your team can join in and provide some back-up singing)
- ❑ **J Amazon.com**, Team placing a completely bogus book review on Amazon.com. **200**
- ❑ **American Pie**, A bar full of strangers singing the song "American Pie" **500** (+**100** for: Drunks, or Drunk Irish, or Don McLean)
- ❑ **American Pie II** A stranger in a marching band uniform saying, "One time at band camp" **400**

- ❑ **Amish Buggy**, TM riding in an Amish buggy. **1500**
- ❑ **Amish**, TM playing the entire day dressed as Amish – oh wait, that’s been done – how about dressed as a Viking. **200**
- ❑ **D J Angry**, TM telling a stranger, “Don’t make me angry Mr. McGee. You wouldn’t like me when I’m angry. **200**
- ❑ **Animal Crackers**, Team feeding animal crackers to live animals. **150** (+**500** if the cracker and animal match)
- ❑ **Animal Slippers**, Entire team in those oh-so-cute enormous animal slippers. **200**
- ❑ **Animals**, Team feeding animals next to a sign that says "DO NOT FEED THE ANIMALS!" **150**
- ❑ **K Animals**, When Animals Attack XVII. **100**
- ❑ **Annie**, Non-TM redhead belting at least the chorus of "Tomorrow." **400** (+**100** if team joins in on reprise)
- ❑ **Ants**, TM scorching ants with a magnifying glass. **100**
- ❑ **Ant Sandwich**, TM putting 6 ants on a piece of bread and folding the bread and eating it. **600**
- ❑ **Arcade Quest**, Team at an arcade posting the high score on a video game. **300** (+**100** for putting “FQ” in the game for your initials)
- ❑ **K Arm Wrestling**, TM arm wrestling a cop. **500**
- ❑ **Armor**, TM in a suit of armor. **1000** (for a real, genuine steel, authentic or authentic material suit of armor.)
- ❑ **Armored Car**, Team inside a Brinks or other armored car. **1500**
- ❑ **K D J Armpits**, TM drying his/her armpits on an air dryer. **500** (+**100** for singing “Get Into the Groove”)
- ❑ **K D j Arnold**, TM using an Arnold Schwarzenegger movie quote during the game. **10** each
- ❑ **Art Museum Fountain**, Team in the fountain at the top of the Art Museum stairs, again. Damn it! It's Filmquest. **600**
- ❑ **Art Museum**, Team at the bottom of the Philadelphia Art Museum steps charging people \$1.00 to run up the stairs like Rocky. Must include a sign. All monies collected will be donated to PBS because we obviously need more culture. **700** (must collect at least \$4)

- ❑ **Art Museum**, TM asking, at the info desk of the Philadelphia Art Museum, "Where are the sad clown exhibits?" **200**
- ❑ **M Art Work**, TM touching a priceless work of art. **500**
- ❑ **Ass Man**, TM shaking hands with a proctologist. **300**
- **Ass**, see COLOR COPY.
- ❑ **K D j Ass**, TM smacking the ass of another Tm after a good stunt. (like a MLB player – wanna make something of it) **25** each TM
- ❑ **Astronomy Observatory**, Team looking at stars inside an observatory. **500** (+**500** if TM discovers a comet and names it “The Filmquest Comet”)
- ❑ **K M D ATM Machine**, Team using an ATM machine that does not charge a fee for non-members. **100**(+**100** if the ATM is not in a WaWa)
- ❑ **Atomic Fire Balls**, TM with five (5) atomic fire balls in his/her mouth for 30 seconds. **400**
- ❑ **Auction**, TM bidding at an auction. **600** (+**100** if they actually buy something)
- ❑ **Automatic Chairlift**, TM riding an automatic chairlift up a flight of stairs.**250**
- ❑ **Baby Back Ribs**, All of the cooks at an Chilies Restaurant singing about how they want their baby back, baby back, baby back ribs. **500**
- ❑ **K J F Baby Pictures**, TM’s showing their own baby pictures. **200** (for each of your TMs)
- ❑ **Bachelor/ Bachelorette Party**, Team at a Bachelor/ Bachelorette party. **500** (+**500** for TM playing the roll of the stripper)
- ❑ **Backhoe**, TM using a backhoe to dig. **1000**
- ❑ **Backstage**, Team back stage at a concert. **500**
- ❑ **Backwards**, Stranger bending over backwards (literally) to help Team get points. **200**
- **Bad Touch**, see DISCOVERY CHANNEL.
- ❑ **D Bag**, TM opening their bag in public and asking the inside of the bag, (every 15 seconds) “You alright in there?” **200**
- ❑ **D Balloon**, TM filling a balloon with coke from a soda fountain. **600** (+**200** need we say BREAKING IT!)

- ❑ **Bally's KOP**, Team running a lap around the track at Bally's King Of Prussia. **600** (+100 if also filmed from outside)
- ❑ **K Banana**, A stranger eating a banana at a supermarket before paying. **500** (Team is disqualified if stranger is arrested)
- ❑ **Banana**, TM dropping a Banana from at least 10 stories. **400**
- ❑ **D J Band Aid**, Using a box of band aids on one TM and walking around in public. **200**
- ❑ **Band, Has Been**, A sign in a bar or club that shows a band that use to be big and now is on the "Has Been" tour. (i.e. The 23 East Presents: Loverboy - \$3 cover) **200**
- ❑ **Bang a Gong**, Get it on, bang a gong. **50**
- ❑ **K Bank Teller**, TM asking a bank teller to "show me the money" **400**
- ❑ **D Banner Quest**, An F2K banner at least 3 feet X 5 feet hanging from an overpass so that it is viewable by cars and people using the underpass. **250**
- ❑ **D J Baptize**, TM baptizing someone. **400**
- ❑ **Bar, Swim-up**, TM at a swim-up bar. **1000**
- ❑ **Barenaked Ladies**, Team with Barenaked Ladies. **2000** for the band; **500** if taken literally
- ❑ **Barn Raising**, Team helping out at a barn raising. **2000**
- ❑ **D Barn**, Team inside of a real barn. **300** (+200 for kissing the farmer's daughter)
- ❑ **Barney**, A Big bouncer at a bar singing the "I love you/ you love me" song from Barney. **300**
- **Baseball Card**, see ROBINSON, JACKIE and DREW, J.D.
- ❑ **X Baseball Card**, TM on his/her own baseball card. **300**
- ❑ **M D Baseball**, Team throwing it around the horn. **200**
- ❑ **Basketball**, TM drop kicking a basketball from the foul line into the hoop. **500**
- ❑ **Basketball**, TM making five (5) free throws in a row on a regulation basketball court from the foul line. **1000** (If TM makes 4 in a row he/ she may quit before taking the 5th shot a receive **500**)
- ❑ **Bathing Suit**, A stranger trying on a bathing suit (not the actual changing into the suit of course, pervert) and telling Team whether or not they think they'll be ready to wear it by Memorial Day.

- ❑ **Baywatch**, Team watching Baywatch in a stranger's home with stranger's family. **800**
- ❑ **Beanie Baby, Destroying**, TM destroying a Beanie Baby with the assistance of a wood chipper. **700**
- ❑ **Bed & Breakfast**, Entire team in bed eating breakfast at a bed & breakfast. **500**
- ❑ **Bed Race**, Team racing 2 beds (that are on wheels) down a street. **1000**
- ❑ **Bee Keeper**, TM wearing a bee keeper's outfit surrounded by lots of bees (no killer bees). **900**(+**1000** for a beard of bees, +**100** for a goatee of bees)
- ❑ **Beer, Case of**. Team having an entire case of beer with no empties at the end of the night. Limit 1 case of beer. **5000** (+**250** for cooler with ice.)
- ❑ **Beer**, TM in a bar drinking a beer with a beer bong right from the tap. **800**
- ❑ **Bell Tower**, TM in a bell tower. **500**
- ❑ **Belly Dancer**, Each belly dancer. **500** (limit 3)
- ❑ **Ben Franklin's Grave**, Team tossing a penny on Ben Franklin's Grave for luck. **300** (+**100** for playing the instant lottery immediately after the penny toss)
- ❑ **M Beth**, TM singing "*Beth*" by Kiss a-capella style. **300**
- ❑ **Bicycle, Antique**, TM riding an antique bicycle with the really big front wheel and little tiny rear wheel. **800**
- ❑ **Bicycle, Tandem**, TMs riding a bicycle built for two. **650**
- ❑ **J Big Time Director**, Team convincing a group of strangers that the team is scouting locations for a new movie. Team must mention the working title, the signed actors and what the film is about. (no set-ups) **600**
- ❑ **Bikini**, TM, male or female, entering a bathing suit, bikini, "hot bod" or something similar contest (Must be a real contest) **1500**
- ❑ **K Bioré Pore Strip**, TM putting and removing a Bioré pore strip on a stranger's nose. **300** (+**100** for showing the dirt)
- ❑ **Bird, Cursing**, A talking bird saying dirty words. **400**

- ❑ **Bird, Talking** A talking bird saying "Filmquest." **1000**
- ❑ **K M Bird**, TM with a bird perched on his/her finger. **250** (+**500** if bird eats from TM mouth)
- ❑ **J Birds, Bees**, TM explaining to group of strangers where babies come from. **400**
- ❑ **K J F Birthday Candle**, TM with a lit birthday candle in his/her nose. **300**
- ❑ **K J Birthday, Kay**, Team wishing Kay Mowers a happy birthday. **100** (Kay turned 30 in April you know)
- ❑ **Black Cat**, crossing the Team's path. **200** (+**100** holding black cat)
- ❑ **K D J F Blair Witch Project**, TM doing a close up scene like Blair Witch Project. TM must wear ski hat, have boogers hanging out of nose, and apologize to other TM's mothers or spouses. **800**
- ❑ **k Black Patent Leather Shoes**, TM checking to see if black patent leather shoes really reflect up. **200**
- **x Blame Canada**, see SOUTH PARK.
- ❑ **D Blonde**, A blonde female stranger telling a dumb brunette joke. **200**
- ❑ **Blood**, TM giving blood. **1500**
- ❑ **Blow Up Doll**, Team sitting in a restaurant with a blow up doll. **500**
- ❑ **Blue Light Special**, TM at Kmart announcing a "Blue Light Special" on Filmquest action figures. **900**
- ❑ **Blue Rocks Stadium**, Team inside Blue Rocks stadium. **1000**
- ❑ **Boat House Row**, Team carrying a sculling shell at boat house row. **600**
- ❑ **Boat Names**, Team filming one boat with a dirty sounding name (not *My Wet Dream*). **500**
- ❑ **Boat Owner**, Team persuading boat-owners who are in their boats to sing "Row Row Row Your Boat." **300** (+**100** if they do it in a "round")
- ❑ **K J Body Builders**, TM posing as a body builder. **200** (+**100** for "official" sounding names for the poses)
- ❑ **Body Wrap**, TM getting a "body wrap" fat-reducing therapy. **200**

- ❑ **D Booboo**, TM placing a band aid on a stranger's booboo. **200** (+**100** for kissing it and making it better)
- ❑ **K Booby Trap**, TM caught in a booby trap. **300**
- ❑ **K F d Booger**, TM eating a booger. **600**
- ❑ **Book Cart**, Team being pushed around on a book cart at Barnes And Noble by the employees. **400**
- ❑ **D J Book Quest**, TM asking for the book "Filmquest For Dummies" in any bookstore. **200** (+**200** if they look it up on the computer and try and order it)
- ❑ **Boomerang**, TM throwing a boomerang. **50** (+**50** if it comes back - no vertical toss)
- ❑ **Boots**, Team doing a choreographed song and dance to "*These Boots Are Made For Walking*". **700**
- ❑ **Bouncer**, TM feeling a bouncer's muscle. **300**
- ❑ **Bowling Jackets**, Team at a bowling alley trying on strangers bowling jackets (or team shirts). Team all at once. **100** per TM (+**100** for holding a bowling trophy)
- ❑ **K F Bowling**, TM at a grocery store bowling down some sort of pins with a honeydew or grapefruit. **300**
- ❑ **K D J Box**, TM thinking outside the box. **50** (+**50** if TM also colors outside of the lines)
- ❑ **Boxing**, TM in sparring gear in a boxing ring. **1000**
- ❑ **K D Bread**, Team giving away a loaf of bread to strangers (one slice per stranger). **1000**
- ❑ **Breakfast At Tiffany's**, TM eating breakfast at Tiffany's. **500** (+**200** if TM eats a bowl full of Coco Puffs at Tiffany's)
- ❑ **Breathalyzer Test**, TM taking a real breathalyzer test. **200** (+**400** if the police administer the test)
- **Build Me Up Buttercup**, see BUTTERCUP.
- ❑ **Bull Horn**, TM using a bull horn in public. **200** (+**300** for asking a stranger "WHAT TIME IS IT.")
- ❑ **J Bum**, TM asking a stranger, "Are you looking at my bum? You cheeky monkey". **200**
- ❑ **Bus Marquee**, Video of the word Filmquest on a bus marquee. **600**

- ❑ **Bus**, Team on a real, full size yellow school bus singing "The Wheels On The Bus". **300** (Video from outside with TMs singing out the window)
- ❑ **D Butt Crack**, TM pretending to be a worker (with a tool belt) in public with their butt crack showing (Must use hidden camera to capture public reaction). **600**
- ❑ **X Butter Commercial**, TM doing a "I Can't Believe It's Not Butter" commercial. **800**
- ❑ **J Butter**, TM eating a stick of butter (8oz). **1000**
- ❑ **M Buttercup**, Small clips of various people singing lines to the song "Build Me Up Buttercup" **50** per clip
- ❑ **Buttons**, Team having Filmquest buttons made. **250**
- ❑ **Caddy**, TM caddying for a stranger at a real county club. No public courses. **1000** (+**100** for an unsolicited tip)
- ❑ **Camden Yards**, Team inside Camden Yards. **1500**
- **Camera Off**, see TURN OFF THAT CAMERA.
- ❑ **X Camera, Out Of My Face**, Any video, that is not set up, of the Team being asked to leave or turn off the camera. **100**
- ❑ **Campaign**, TM removing a campaign sign for a candidate the TM does not like. **350**
- ❑ **J Candidate**, Team endorsing a fictitious presidential candidate (this is an election year people) **250** (+**100** for flyers, +**100** if TM puts their candidates flyer in place of one that was removed)
- ❑ **K Candle**, TM lighting a candle in a church and saying a Filmquest Victory Prayer. **400**
- ❑ **Car Carrier**, Team car on a car carrier truck. **1000** (all the way on)
- ❑ **Car Dealership**, Team having a car dealer put a front plate (with the dealerships name) on the team car. **500**
- ❑ **M Car Decorating**, Team decorating a stranger's car with crepe paper and balloons and leaving a note about it being from a secret admirer. **600**
- ❑ **K Car Horn**, TM playing a car horn that plays a tune. **500**
- ❑ **Car Load**, Video of a car with it's load not properly tied down. **200**
- ❑ **Car Wash**, Washing a stranger in a car wash. Must include the scrubby brush. **900**

- ❑ **K D Car, Stranger's**, TM driving a stranger's car. **600**
- **Car, Team**, see TEAM VEHICLE.
- ❑ **Car**, TM buying a car. A real car. **1500**
- ❑ **Car**, Video of a car with different color pieces like it was made from leftover cars. **200**
- ❑ **Carnival**, TM operating a ride at a carnival. **800**
- ❑ **J Cartwheel**, Male asking a lady in a dress or skirt if she would do a cartwheel for him. **400** (she must do it or no points)
- ❑ **Casey at the Bat**, TM doing a dramatic reading of "Casey at the Bat" in Casey's Bar. Required: an audience of five. **200**
- ❑ **M Cat Call**, Female TM cat-calling a construction worker "Hey baby you got fries with that shake." **300**
- ❑ **K M D Celebration**, TM male or female removing his/her shirt after a successful Filmquest stunt. **400** (+**200** if he/she is wearing a sports bra like Chastian)
- ❑ **Celebrity Filmquest**, Team asking a celebrity to join their Filmquest team. (i.e. "Excuse me Ken Griffey Jr., would you like to play on our Filmquest team"?) **1500**
- ❑ **J Celebrity Look-A-Likes**, TM approaching a celebrity look-a-like and insisting that they are talking to the REAL celebrity even after the person says it's not them. **500** (They must have some resemblance)
- **Celebrity Quest**, see Attached Sheet.
- ❑ **J F Celebrity Skin**, TM discussing the top five celebrities they would like to sleep with. **300** (+**100** for making a list and getting it laminated.)
- ❑ **Cement**, TM writing Filmquest in wet cement. **900**
- ❑ **F Census 2000**, NO SET-UPS!! 2 TMs get into a stranger's house by posing as Census Bureau personnel to conduct census 2000 interviews which will be videotaped. Goal is to induce visible, discernable discomfort in the stranger (interviewee) by the increasingly strange/invasive nature of the questions asked. **1000** (Filmquest supports the random sampling method)
- ❑ **Century 21**, TM in Century 21 Blazer. **250** per TM (all at once)
- ❑ **Chain Gang, Working On The**, Team getting highway construction crew to sing Chain Gang. **350**

- ❑ **D Chapman, Graham**, Graham Chapman; dead or just being difficult. **25**
- ❑ **Checkered Flag**, TM taking the checkered flag. **100**
- **X Cheeky Monkey**, see BUM.
- ❑ **k Cheerios**, Team tallying their points with cheerios. **200** (+**100** for counting to the Police song “I Can’t Stand Losing”)
- ❑ **Cheerleaders**, Video of cheerleaders in full dress doing a Filmquest cheer. **500**
- **Cheers Theme**, See NICK'S BAR AND GRILL.
- ❑ **Cheese Steaks**, TM grilling up some cheese steaks in a restaurant for the team to eat. **600**
- X Cheeze Whiz, see EASY CHEEZE.
- **Chefs Hat**, see RESTAURANT.
- ❑ **D Cherry Picker**, TM in a cherry picker basket (the raised platform of a truck with a hydraulic lift) at least 20 feet up. **1500**
- ❑ **K Cherry Stem**, TM tying a cherry stem into a knot with his/her tongue. **500**
- ❑ **Chess**, Strangers playing Speed Chess in a park. **300**
- ❑ **Chicken**, TM chasing after a chicken (must get within a foot of actually catching the chicken). **500**
- ❑ **K D Chocolate Syrup**, TM using a squeeze bottle of chocolate syrup to squeeze a mouthful directly into a stranger's mouth. **200**
- ❑ **Chocolate**, TM eating any chocolate covered insect. **500**
- ❑ **Chrysler**, Team fitting 20 people in a Chrysler. **400** (+**100** if someone has Jukebox money)
- ❑ **Church Collection**, TM taking up the collection in a church. **500** (-**100** and eternal damnation if TM keeps the money)
- ❑ **Church Organ**, TM playing a church organ. **300** (+**500** for recognizable song)
- ❑ **K D Church**, Team inside of a church or any house of worship. **200** each different religion. (Filmquest supports freedom of religion)

- ❑ **CIA**, Team innocently stumbling upon a CIA cover-up. **500** (+**500** if the government puts team into "Filmquest Relocation")
- ❑ **K M Cinema Vomité**, TM vomiting while doing a Filmquest stunt. No purging. **300**
- ❑ **Citizens Arrest**, TM making a citizens arrest. **200**
- ❑ **City Hall**, Team in walkway underneath City Hall, Philadelphia. **300**
- ❑ **Class Reunion**, Team crashing a class reunion. **600** (+**100** for each TM in a "Hi, I'm ____" Name Tag, +**100** for TM pretending to "remember" a stranger)
- ❑ **Class**, TM auditing a class. **400**
- ❑ **D Clock**, TM punching the clock. **25** per TM
- ❑ **Close Encounter**, Team having a close encounter of the third kind. **2000** (+**1000** for a close encounter of the second kind)
- ❑ **Closed, The Park is**, An official at a fair/ amusement park saying, "Sorry folks, the park is closed. The Moose out front should have told you." **600** (+**100** if John Candy lookalike)
- **Closing Song**, See GOODNIGHT.
- ❑ **D J Clothing Rack**, Entire team hiding inside of a clothing rack in a department store. Team must not be visible from outside. **400**
- ❑ **K D Clothing**, Two TM's swapping all the clothes they are wearing while in a public place. Keep your own unmentionables – we don't want to spread social disease. **500** (+**600** for also swapping with a stranger)
- ❑ **Clown Shoes**, Entire Team in giant clown shoes. **600**
- ❑ **K J F Coca Cola Roulette**, One can of coke for each TM. One TM shakes one can (a good shaking) and places them in random order. Each TM then picks and opens a can. **300**
- ❑ **K Cockroach**, TM holding a live cockroach barehanded. **1000**
- ❑ **Cod Liver Oil**, TM swallowing 2 spoonfuls of cod liver oil. **350** (Filmquest is moving! Filmquest is not responsible for extreme bowel discomfort)
- ❑ **D J Coffee**, TM drinking a coffee (normal size) with 14 sugars. **400**
- ❑ **Coffin**, TM in a real coffin. **800** (Filmquest is creepy)

- ❑ **k Coke, Large**, TM drinking a large McDonald's Coke in under one (1) minute. TM must use the straw. **650**
- ❑ **Cola Wars**, Video of a Coke driver in uniform drinking a Pepsi (or vice versa) **500**
- ❑ **Comedy Club**, TM telling joke at an open mike night at a comedy club. **1500**
- ❑ **Comfort**, TM showing another TM cold comfort. **100**
- ❑ **Company Picnic**, Team attending a company picnic. **800** (+**100** for getting a meal, +**250** for shaking hands with CEO) **Company Song**, Any non-TM employee of a company singing their product/company jingle/theme-song. **150** (limit 3)
- ❑ **D Computer**, Team destroying an old computer with baseball bats. **700**
- ❑ **Concrete Deer**, TM astride a concrete deer (the kind that otherwise seemingly tasteful people inexplicably consider attractive lawn decor). **300**
- ❑ **Conductor Quest**, Train conductor (real, at a train and train station) shouting "All aboard for Filmquest 2000!" **500**
- ❑ **Confession**, TM filming a church confession. **500** (+**100** if TM confesses something from Filmquest 2000)
- ❑ **Construction Sign**, Team getting a construction crew to put "Filmquest Rules" on a digital sign that usually warns about lousy traffic. **800**
- **X Construction Worker**, See CAT CALL.
- ❑ **Construction**, TM holding a slow/stop sign at a construction site. **500** (+**200** for hard hat and shiny vest)
- ❑ **Convention**, Team attending/crashing a convention. **600** (+**150** for each TM with a nametag)
- ❑ **Conveyer-belt**, Team riding a conveyer-belt apparatus like they had at Best. **1000**
- ❑ **J Cool Whip**, TM eating an entire container of Cool Whip in 1 minute. **700**
- ❑ **K J f Copilot**, Video of driver and copilot working together while navigating the game (Talk to me Goose). **100**
- **Couples**, see MATCHING COUPLES.
- ❑ **Courtroom**, Team in a judicial courtroom. **400**

- ❑ **Cow**, TM roping a cow. **800** (+**1200** for branding a cow)
- ❑ **D Crayon**, Team collecting 46 red crayons from various restaurants kid's menus. **500**

- ❑ **Z Traffic**, TM closing a road and diverting traffic. **900** (+**100** for cones or a red flag) Team must turn at least 2 cars away.
- ❑ **Train Tracks**, Penny, Team flattening a penny on Railroad tracks. **400**
- ❑ **Tram Car**, TM on the boardwalk in New Jersey driving the tram car (at least 100 feet). **900**
- ❑ **K M D Tree**, TM humping and licking and making out with a tree. **50** each TM (must be different trees)
- ❑ **X Truck Stop**, Team in the shower at a truck stop. **500**
- ❑ **Truck**, TM driving a Tractor Trailer at least 100 feet (that's the 18 wheel type truck) **900**
- ❑ **M Truth or Dare**, TM playing truth or dare with another TM. **500** each TM (The dare is something on the Filmquest 2000 list – NOT Random Act – you get the points for the stunt too) (+**500** if TM also does the double dog dare - A truth better be good)
- ❑ **Tulips**, Team tiptoeing through the tulips. **100**
- ❑ **Turn Off That Camera**, Video of a stranger telling TM to turn off the camera or anything to that effect. No setups. **100** each
- ❑ **Turtle, Yertle**, TM stacking live turtles. **200**
- ❑ **Turtles**, Team racing 2 turtles (slow and steady wins the race). **200**
- ❑ **Twins, Babies**, Footage of twins. **200** (No relatives)(+**50** if the twins are dressed alike)
- ❑ **Twister**, TM playing Twister with strangers in an elevator. **400**

- ❑ **Two Dollars**, TM chasing a stranger yelling "I want my \$2!" **300**
- ❑ **Umpire**, TM umpiring one batter in any organized baseball. **800**
- ❑ **Underoos**, TM wearing authentic Underoos---the underwear that's fun to wear. **500**
- ❑ **X Unicycle**, TM riding a unicycle (or respectably staying atop one briefly). **500**
- ❑ **D J Union**, TM looking for the union label. **50**
- ❑ **Valet Parking**, TM valet parking a stranger's car. **600** (+75 if wearing a red valet vest)
- ❑ **X VanHalen**, TM becoming the new lead singer of VanHalen. **1000** (+1000 if TM makes more than one album)
- ❑ **D Vegetable**, TM drinking a cup of vegetable oil. **500**
- ❑ **D Vehicle**, Team pushing team vehicle without the motor running. Car must travel 25 feet. **300**
- ❑ **Velcro Jump**, TM in a Velcro suit jumping & sticking to a Velcro wall. **1000**
- ❑ **M F Velveeta**, TM eating a 5 inch block of America's favorite cheese imitation Velveeta. **300**
- ❑ **Velvet Elvis**, Team admiring a painting of Elvis Presley on black velvet. **300**
- ❑ **K d Vending Machine**, TM buying something from a vending machine and pretending that they received a very large electrical shock. (must be done in public - no set ups) **300**
- ❑ **D J Video Store**, TM asking seriously at a video store, "Do you have that movie with that guy from that movie that came out last year?" No setups. **1000**
- **Videophobe**, see TURN OFF THAT CAMERA.
- **Viking**, see AMISH.
- ❑ **Vine**, TM swinging on a vine a la Tarzan. **300**
- ❑ **J F Virgin, Filmquestor**, Each new TM. **500**
- ❑ **Virtual Reality**, TM playing a virtual reality game wearing some kind of goofy-looking futuristic equipment. **400**
- **Vomit Fest 2000**, See CINEMA VOMITÉ.

- ❑ **X Vote, Register**, TM registering 5 strangers to vote. (Filmquest rocks the vote) **250**
- ❑ **D VW Beetle**, TM test driving the 2000 VW Beetle (driving means leaving the lot). **800**
- ❑ **VW Bus**, Team in a 1970's VW Bus. **500**
- ❑ **X Walking Tour**, TM giving a walking tour to strangers. **100** per non-TM walker
- ❑ **Wall Paper**, Five examples of really ugly wall paper (no sample books). **200**
- ❑ **J Wall Walking**, TM climbing the walls of a narrow hallway. **100** sort of; **200** halfway; **300** for the distance baby!
- ❑ **Wall-Mart Prices**, TMs watching for falling prices at Wal-Mart or knocking prices over. **200**
- ❑ **Wal-Mart**, Team finding a Wal-Mart employee who actually speaks sign language **400** (+**100** points if the employee signs Filmquest)
- ❑ **Wal-Mart Greeter**, TM in official vest acting as a "greeter" in a Wal-mart store. **500**
- ❑ **Wang Chung**, Everybody Wang Chung tonight. **100**
- ❑ **Wanted Poster**, TM who looks like a Wanted Poster. **50** (+**50** if TM is not the wanted felon)
- ❑ **War**, Team getting Military men (in uniform) singing "War (huh...what is it good for)". **500**
- ❑ **Warner Brother's Store**, Team putting "Filmquest" on the marquee inside of any Warner Brother's Store. **500**
- ❑ **Warning**, Team receiving a written warning from the police. **500**(+**100** if it says "Filmquest is arresting)
- ❑ **X Wassup**, TM getting strangers to do wassup! like in the bud commercials. **10** each
- ❑ **Water Balloon Fight**, Team having a water balloon fight with another team. **400** Teams must officially declare war. Otherwise it's only a police action and that doesn't really count.
- ❑ **Water Balloon**, TM drop kicking a water balloon. (balloon must break on TM's foot) **150**
- ❑ **Water slide**, TM sliding down a water slide. **400**
- ❑ **Water Vessel**, TM on a sinking water vessel singing "My Heart Will Go On." **1000**
- ❑ **Water**, TM drinking 8 glasses of water in a row. Each glass of water should be about 8 oz. **300** per TM all at once. (☹ of Filmquest is covered with water)

- ❑ **K Watermelon**, TM walking around in watermelon shoes. **800**
- ❑ **X Wave**, Team starting a wave at a little league game. **500** (minimum of 25 strangers)
- ❑ **K Wave, Church**, TMs doing the wave in a church pew. **350** (+**1000** points for priest participation)
- ❑ **Weather map**, TM in front of weather map for a local news station. **1500**
- ❑ **J Web Quest**, Team web page -- your tape must show at least three pages displayed on a computer with substantial content. **1000** (+**500** if shown on a floor-model computer in a computer or other retail store)
- ❑ **Wedding Cake**, TM sticking a finger in a wedding cake. **300**
- ❑ **J Wedding Proposal**, Team filming an actual wedding proposal. (must include a ring or a crying female) **400**
- ❑ **Wedding Rice**, Team tossing rice/bird seed or whatever at a bride & groom as they exit the church. **500**
- ❑ **Wedding Toast**, TM giving a toast at a wedding (This does not mean crashing the wedding which was done in grand fashion during Filmquest 1997) **1000**
- ❑ **Wedding**, Team decorating a car at a wedding. **350**
- ❑ **Wedgie**, TM giving a stranger a Wedgie. **200** each (+**100** each for stranger digging them out)
- ❑ **Weeping Willow**, TM crying under a weeping willow. **200**
- ❑ **Weighing**, Team weighing team vehicle at a weighing station. **600**
- ❑ **Weight Room**, Male TM going up to a woman at a pool and saying, "Hi, could you tell me where the weight room is." **500**
- ❑ **Welcome Center**, Team being welcomed by the employees of a state welcome center. **200** per state (50max)
- ❑ **Welcome Sign**, Team posing with a sign that says Welcome to "Where Ever *". Team must stand with the sign. **50** each (*insert a town name here)
- ❑ **Welding**, TM welding. **500** (+**1000** if you weld team vehicle doors shut and use the windows to enter and exit.
- ❑ **X Wet Willie**, TM giving a stranger a wet Willie. **300**

- ❑ **D Whack-A-Mole**, Entire team helping in a great cheat in whack-a-mole or the equivalent. **100** each game
- **Wheels On The Bus**, See BUS.
- ❑ **When Harry Met Sally**, Female TM in a restaurant in public recreating the diner scene from "When Harry Met Sally" **600** (+**100** if a stranger says, "I'll have what she's having")
- ❑ **D Whiffle Ball**, TM throwing a sweeping curve ball with a wiffle ball. **50** (+**50** if another TM hits it)
- ❑ **Whipped Silicone**, Female TM trying on the new "Whipped Silicone" bra at Fredericks of Hollywood. Must have before and after shots. **300**
- ❑ **D Whistle**, Team whistling "Whistle While You Work" while they are working. **50**
- ❑ **X Whoop Ass**, TM opening a can of whoop ass. **100**
- **X Wiiiill-buuurrr**, see MISTER ED.
- ❑ **Wild Side**, TM walking on the wild side. **100**
- ❑ **Window**, TM climbing through a window. **300** (+**400** if TM is carrying a television)
- ❑ **M Window, Car**, Entire team entering team vehicle through the windows. **500**
- ❑ **Wine Cellar**, Team in the wine cellar of a restaurant. **500** (+**100** if a TM pretends to have a James Bond type knowledge of wine)
- ❑ **J d Wine**, TM holding the cheapest bottle of wine they can find. (must be under \$5) **200** (+**100** for buying it and bringing it to the after party)
- ❑ **Wings**, TM eating 10 homicide wings at *Wings To Go*. **800**
- ❑ **Winnebago**, TM driving a Winnebago with the team in the back acting like the morons on Road Rules. **800** (TM's must refer to the vehicle as "The Winnie")
- ❑ **Winner's Circle**, Team in the winner's circle after a race. **1500**
- ❑ **Witch**, A real-live witch in some kind of official looking witch-garb. TM should ask, "Are you a good witch, or a bad witch?" **500**
- ❑ **Witch, Steak**, A witch burning a steak. **500** (only **350** if it's medium or rare)
- ❑ **K D Woods, Tiger**, TM juggling a golf ball on a club like Tiger Woods. Must catch the ball 4 times in a row. **300** (+**100** for smacking the ball after the 4th hit)

- ❑ **J d World, It's the End of the**, TM doing a dramatic reading of the REM song "*It's the End Of the World*" **100** (Must include one verse and the chorus)
- ❑ **Wrong Way**, Team pulling up next to a stranger in another car and telling them that they are going the wrong way. **200**
- ❑ **D WWF**, TM doing a really choreographed WWF move. Please no pile drivers. **200**
- ❑ **X-Files**, Team poses as camera crew for cable TV pilot about paranormal activities, gaining access to stranger's house which your records show as being haunted. Get footage inside house explaining to stranger the gruesome tale of what happened there. **1000**
- ❑ **D J Y2K**, Team finding something that is not Y2K compliant. **150**
- ❑ **D j Zen**, Video of a moment of Zen. **100**
- ❑ **X Zoot Suit**, TM wearing one of those big shouldered zoot suits in public. **350**
